#### Protecting your ID on line

January 28th is Data Privacy & Protection Day, an international holiday. The goal of this holiday is to raise awareness of protecting privacy online.

#### 1. BE ALERT TO PHISHING

Phishing is an email that impersonates a trusted business. Check spellings carefully. NEVER give out personal information( credit card, SS number or Medicare number) to someone you have not initiated contact with.

#### 2. HAVE A STRONG PASSWORD

The longer your password the harder it is for cyber criminals to hack. You should include letters, numbers and symbols. You should also change your passwords often.

#### 3. DO NOT ANSWER SOCIAL MEDIA QUIZZES

Scammers use these to get information without you realizing it. If you answer things like "Who was your favorite teacher?" or "What was your first car?" These are answers to many security questions.

#### 4. IRS or POLICE WILL NEVER CALL YOU

The police will NEVER call you announcing they have a warrant out for your arrest. IRS will never ask for payment in the form of gift cards. If you are unsure who is actually calling you, hang up and call the official number listed.

## **★ ARC** (Architectural Review Committee)

Happy New Year! Along with the new year come new rules for ARC, so, I have a few things to share. First off, there are new documents with all the changes for 2025. Please reference them before you plan any outside projects. Also, please keep in mind that Florida state statues supersedes our documents. You can find them at: http://www.leg.state.fl.us/ under the tab LAWS. Those that applyto ARC start with 720.3035. One area under the state statues is Flagpoles. This Florida statue is section 720.304 2.a if you'd like to read the whole thing. The key points here are: 1) you can fly 2 flags; 2) they can't be larger that 4 1/2 feet by 6 feet; 3) you can have one flagpole no higher than 20 feet; 4) the flagpole can not be in the easement. If you need an ARC form, new ones can be found in the Blvd clubhouse. Not sure you need to fill one out? When in doubt, fill one out. Along this line, please turn in your ARC form before you start your project. That way you know what you're planning is both Polo Park and Florida statues approved. If you would like to come to our weekly meetings you are welcome to come. We meet at 10:30 on Wednesdays at the Blvd. Clubhouse. As always, thank you for helping to keep Polo Park beautiful.

Our bylaws provide for the use of the clubhouses for private parties. At the April 2023 meeting, the Board approved the fee of \$200.00 for private parties to help with the costs of maintaining the clubhouses. The \$200.00 fee will cover the use of the clubhouse for (6) six hours. Use of the clubhouse beyond the (6) six hours will be charged an additional \$100.00 per hour. An additional \$200.00 refundable deposit will be due 48 hours prior to the event. Notice of a private party will be posted on the door of the clubhouse during a private function. Please.....let's have respect for our neighbors and their families who are having a private function. We're sure you would want the same respect and consideration given to you.




